

Annual Report Jorhat College, 2022-23

Jorhat College (Amalgamated situated in the heart of the Jorhat town is an institution of higher learning with a legacy of long sixty years. It is affiliated to Dibrugarh University and managed by a Governing body. The college has an effective IQAC cell which plans all the activities of the college. As per University Academic Calender the Academic session of the college starts on 1st August, 2022. End semester examinations are conducted twice in a year. For Odd semester examinations are conducted in the months of November- December and Even semesters are in the month of May-June. Examinations are conducted in a totally dis centralized system. Academic activities are supervised by both IQAC and Vice Principal(Academic). Apart from academic activities, the college has planned different activities in different sphere. An account of these activities is given below.

Activities planned and executed

- The college is celebrating its Diamond Jubilee in this session.
- 275 students were admitted in the new academic session, enhancing the total strength of the college to 717.
- The college has successfully organized the ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ campaign to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India’s independence from 13th August to 15th August, 2023. The idea behind the initiative is to invoke the feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the people and to promote awareness about the Indian National Flag.
