


Annual Report of IQAC, 2021-22

In the year 2021-22, IQAC held total 5 meetings where many important decisions were taken and implemented. In this report an attempt is made to reflect the activities of the college as a whole.

Activity planned and executed:

- IQAC has purchased an online platform for holding the webinars and workshops. The departments tested the platform with departmental meetings and reported that the platform is providing good service.
- The NAAC Peer team visit was conducted on 21st and 22nd October. Everybody in the college have performed their duties well and the visit was completed with high satisfaction. The college received B++ with 2.79 CGPA.
- IQAC formed a committee to find the possibilities of introducing self financing courses. The committee has placed the report on introduction of self-financing courses. It is mentioned in the report that if we can introduce the course in all the semester nearly 10 lakhs rupees will be generated but to start the course effectively, it is mentioned that a good work out is needed to select the courses and to find proper resource persons. 24 courses were identified. Syllabuses were prepared and sent to the university for approval. The college is ready to start the courses in the next academic session.
- National Webinar on Centenary of Chargola Exodus: A Bloody Saga of Indian Freedom Struggle jointly by Political Science Department, Jorhat college and Gurucharan College in collaboration with IQAC, Jorhat College on 4th December.
- The Philosophy department of the college has planned and organised three national level webinars on 18th & 29th November and 30th December, 2021 in collaboration with IQAC and with the financial assistance of ICPR.
- Student Mentoring system is implemented satisfactorily.
- Due to the regular follow up of course progression, the college is able to maintain its result in the end semester examinations.

- The Career Counselling has initiated the process for holding a few programmes.

- The coordinator has placed a report in the meeting for procuring ERP. Process is started for procuring the ERP.
- A programme was organized to pay homage to Bhagat Singh
- A workshop on Intellectual Property right was held on 26th April, 2022.
- A meeting was held with the HoDs and some other faculty members to conduct an academic audit to ensure quality in teaching learning process.
- The college has taken initiative to bring the famous Kahinor Diamond and the Peacock throne from England. On 24th May a mail was sent to the British Embassy in this regard. All departments prepared two canvases for collecting signatures on that day in support of this move. This process will continue.
- A committee is formed for the celebration of Kahinor Jubilee or Diamond Jubilee of the college .
- It was celebrated in a grand way. The Late Gitartha Barua Memorial art Gallery was inaugurated on that day in a grand function.
- Two programmes were held on career counselling. A sale cum exhibition of products prepared by the students was organised on 5th June, 2022. A book review programme was held on Arupa Patangiya's *Jyotsnar Jhitas*.
- International Yoga Day was celebrated with lecture cum demonstration programme.
