## Revised guidelines for admissions to FYUGP (Four-year Undergraduate Programme) B.A. Degree, Academic session 2024

1. Admission for FYUGP (Four-year Undergraduate Programme), will also be provisioned only through the common admission portal <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>
2. Students will get six options for program selection either in the same Higher Educational Institution (University/Colleges) or in different Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)(University/Colleges).
3. Students need to mark preferences against the options of programs.
4. The Merit list may be prepared by the University/Colleges based on the student's preference, subject to the fulfilment of merit criteria required for admission to that University/College.
5. HEIs/ Colleges will mark the students considered for offering admission by processing the merit list in the admission portal itself. Once marked and saved by the HEI/College, the merit list for the programs will be auto-generated and visible to students in the “**merit list section**” of the admission portal <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>
6. The students will receive an **admission offer message** with a **URL in their registered e-mail and mobile number** for further processing. Only upon **acceptance of the admission offer** by the applicant by logging into their admission portal, the Universities or Colleges **will be able to process** the application for **grant of admission**.
7. Colleges and Universities will have the discretion to check and verify the Income certificates (the validity of the claim regarding the status of income **below Rupees 2 lakh**) produced by applicants at the time of admission. The **Ration Card** may be given as an income document.

### **Key points for Counselling of Aspirants seeking Admission in FYUGP (B.A. Degree),2024**

- # For new registration a valid mobile number and an email id are must.
- # An applicant must register in Samarth with their own mobile and email. They should not try for multiple registrations using the same mobile and email-id.
- # Applicants can enjoy the services of CSC (Common Service Centre like Arunodoi Centres at reasonable rates.
- # Students applying for B.A. under Dibrugarh University have to select NEP stream
- # The applications have to provide all the correct necessary details in the application, else the application would not be accepted.
- # Level of Disability should be considerable (Level like 25% etc. may not be accepted)
- # Size of uploads/documents should be between 10 kb to 500kb
- # The applicants should be very careful while filling the applications.
- # (Any changes / rectifications may be possible at the time of Spot Admission)
- # CUET applicants can also apply in NON-CUET colleges.
- # OTP must be submitted after completion of the application forms. Otherwise, the forms will remain unsubmitted.
- # Avoid auto correction mode in mobile and laptops/desktops
