ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK FROM ALUMNI

The alumni of the college have provided their feedback on the curriculum through the structured questionnaire.

There are thirteen questions.

The first question was on “Depth of the course content including project work if any”. 66% (132) responded as “Very Good” and 34%(68) (percent of the students opined as “Good”.

As far as the “Extent of coverage of course”, 75%(150) responded as “Very Good” and 22%(44) opined as “Good” and 3%(06) opined as ‘satisfactory’.

In the question related to “Applicability / relevance to real life situation”, 68%(136) considered as “Very Good” and 27%(54) as “Good” & 5%(10) responded as “satisfactory”.

In the case of “Learning Value (in terms of knowledge, concept, manual skills, analytical abilities, broadening perspectives)” 65% (130) opined as “Very Good” and 31% (62) as “Good” and 4% (08) opined as “Satisfactory”.

In the “Clarity and relevance of textual reading materials”, 72% of the alumni responded as “Very Good” and 26% responded as “Good” and 2% responded as “satisfactory”.

Regarding the relevance of additional source materials (library) the 77%(154) marked “Very Good” 21%(42) as “Good” and 2% as “Satisfactory”.

76% of the alumni marked as “Very Good” for the “Extent of effort required by students” and 21% as “Good” & 3% as “satisfactory”.
