

## Student Satisfaction Survey 2023 – 2024

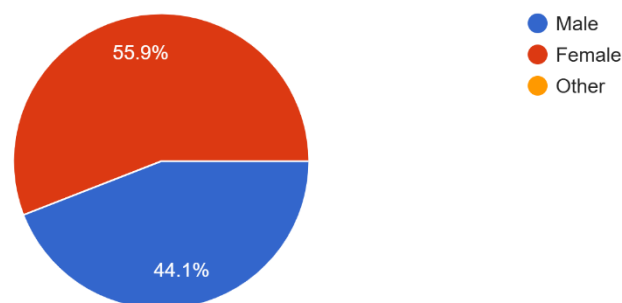
### A Brief Analyses of the Data obtained:

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted during the 2023-2024 session online using Google Forms. In all 304 students took part in the survey of which 44.1% were male and 55.9% were female respondents; respondents from BA 6<sup>th</sup> semester, 4<sup>th</sup> semester, and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester were 45.7%, 35.5%, and 18.8% respectively. In most of the areas covered under the survey, it is observed that the general tendency of the responses of the students is towards the positive with the major chunk of students being ‘satisfied’ with the facilities provided by the college, and a sizeable percentage (10% to 30%) of the students choosing ‘very satisfied’/ ‘slightly satisfied’ option. Although the data conclusively reveals that the students in general are satisfied with the facilities, there are students (27.3%) who have expressed dissatisfaction with canteen facilities; but even in that case, most of the students (72.7%) expressed satisfaction with the facilities in the canteen. Regarding the Boys’/Girls’ Common Room facilities, it is seen that there are dissenting voices which is revealing; this finding has been taken up by the college authority very seriously and plans are being formulated to address the matter. Again, with regards to sporting facilities, the survey throws up an interesting finding – the general tendency of the survey is positive but 8.9% holds a dissenting voice which is being examined by the authority. Further, with regards to the library facilities, office services, cultural activities, students’ union election etc, the responses of the students show a positive tendency.

So, the Student Satisfaction Survey reveals that most of the students are satisfied with the facilities in the college; but there is a small percentage of students who beg to differ. The authority is sincerely working to iron out the creases and make life in college for students positive and satisfying.

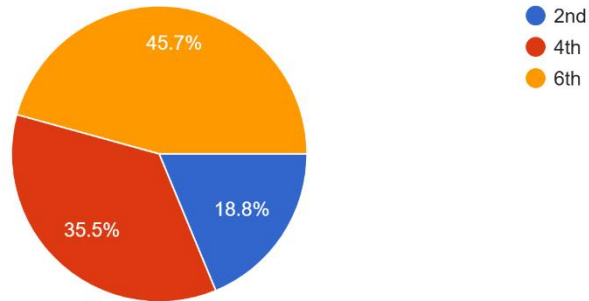

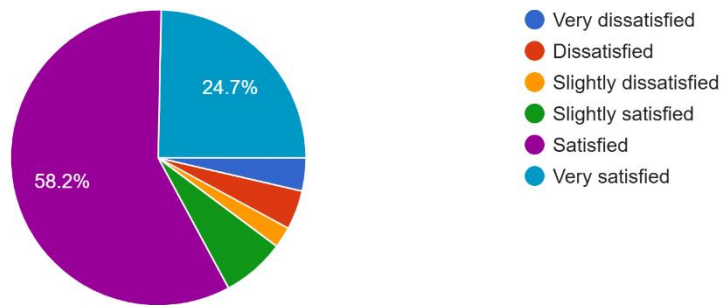

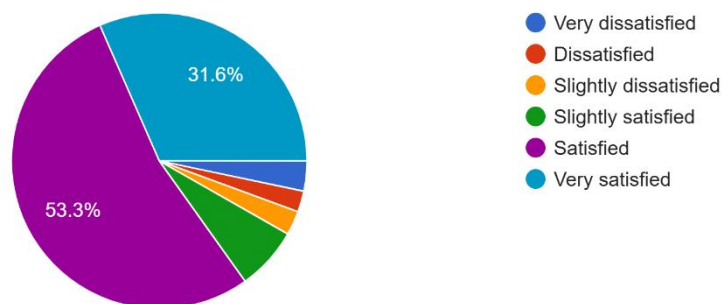

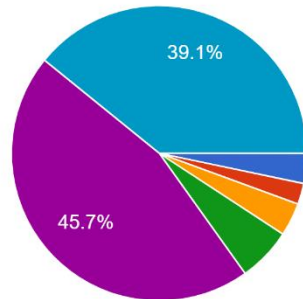

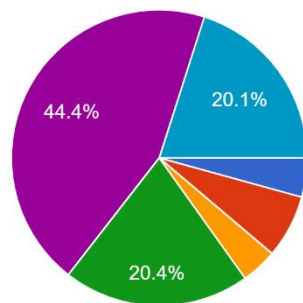

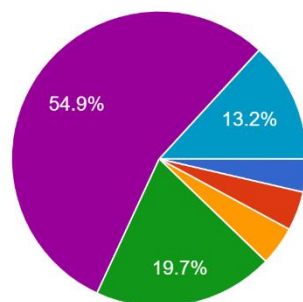

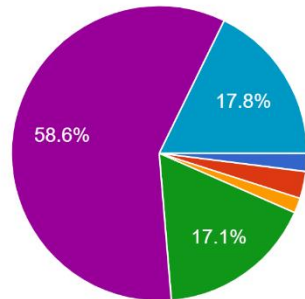

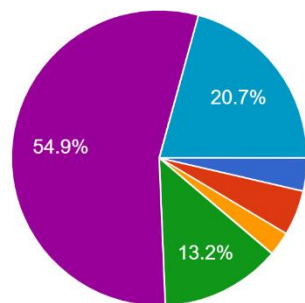

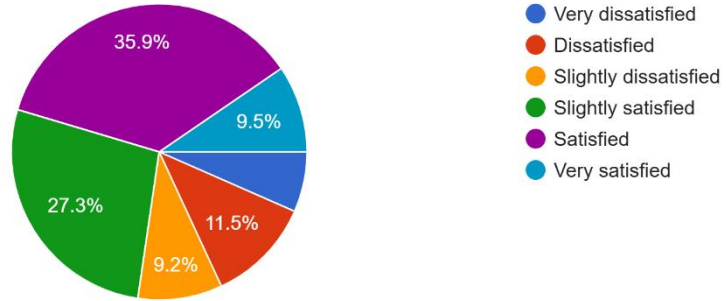

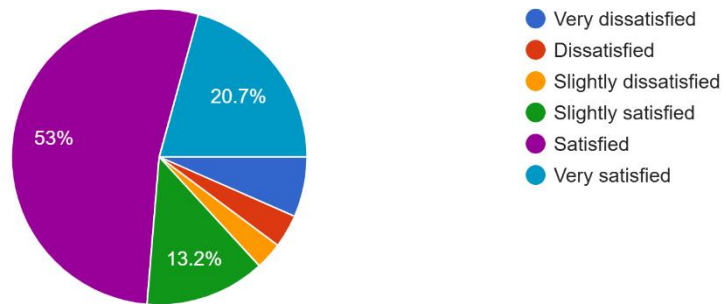

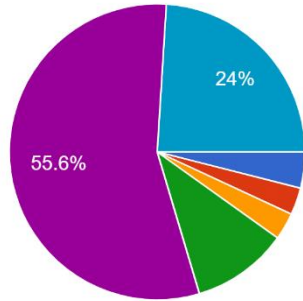

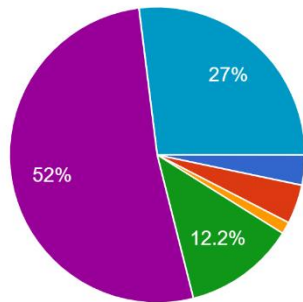

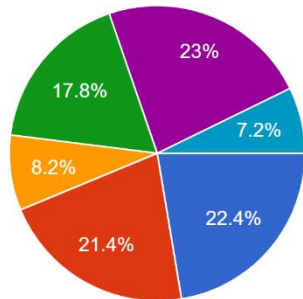

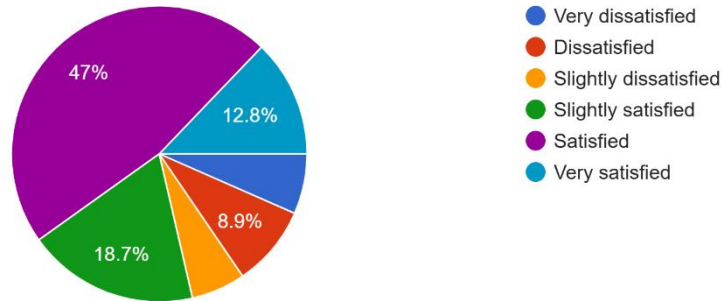

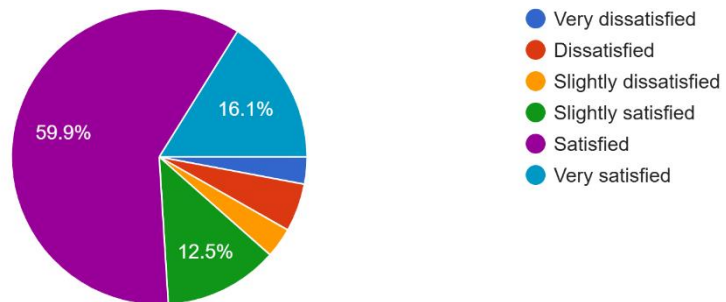

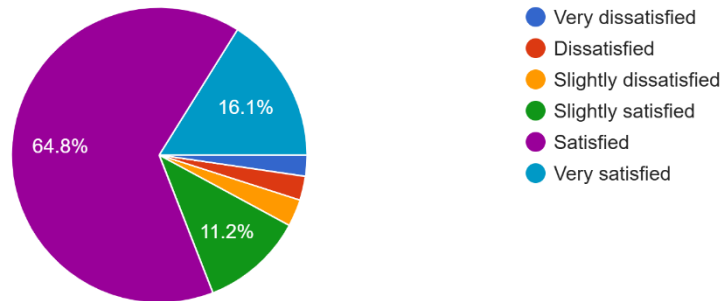
